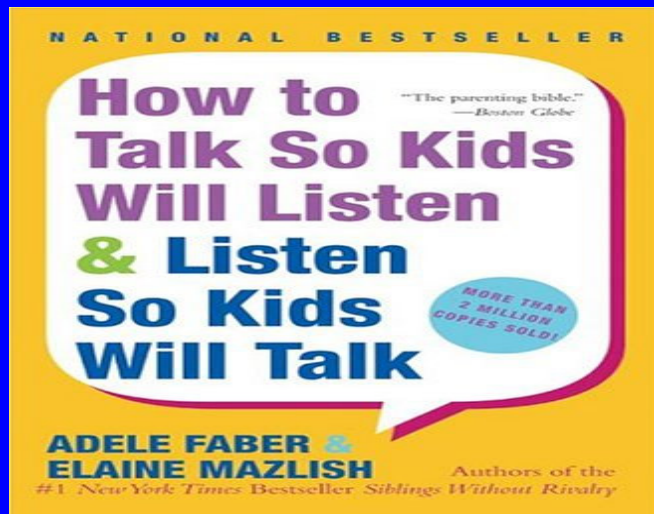

Darfur Solidarity Forum (DSF) Update



Darfur Solidarity Forum (DSF) update

The Darfur Solidarity Forum (DSF) is a private initiative organized by a concerned Sudanese group. Its main objective is to address the humanitarian disaster in Darfur, Sudan.

The DSF is specifically focusing its efforts to assist displaced children and help provide for their educational needs. The DSF is also increasing awareness and disseminating information about the Darfur crisis to the Canadian public. It is also establishing close relationships with Canadian Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) in Darfur.

The main activities of the Darfur Solidarity Forum is to:

- Raise funds for the educational needs of displaced children in Darfur
- Conduct public awareness campaigns about Darfur
- Lobby the Prime Minister, Cabinet Ministers, politicians and senior officials at all levels of government to promote the need for sustained support to overcome the crisis in Darfur
- Rally support amongst Canadians to support humanitarian efforts being done by the Darfur Solidarity Forum
- Solicit membership and participation in the efforts of the Darfur Solidarity Forum
- Meet with officials from NGOs to coordinate and carry out positive plans and action
- Conduct research and analysis

Results and Achievements

1. Toward the end of Ramadan DSF collected Zakat El-Fitr and an amount of \$ 1,135.00 Cdn which was sent urgently through Human Concerns International (HCI) to Darfur children. A report covering how this amount spent will be sent by HCI to the Darfur Solidarity Forum. Tax receipts for those who donated more than \$10.00 Cdn will be issued in February 2005. An appreciation note to those who generously supported that effort was also e-mailed.
2. A flyer has been designed and refined to be used in the upcoming **door-to-door** campaign to be launched on December 5th 04. Donation boxes were brought in from HCI in support to this campaign.
3. In addition to the above fund raising event, other major activities such as dinners, parties, and bazaars etc. will also generate funds for this important and worthwhile cause.

As for Research and Analysis, the forum has and makes available an abundance of data

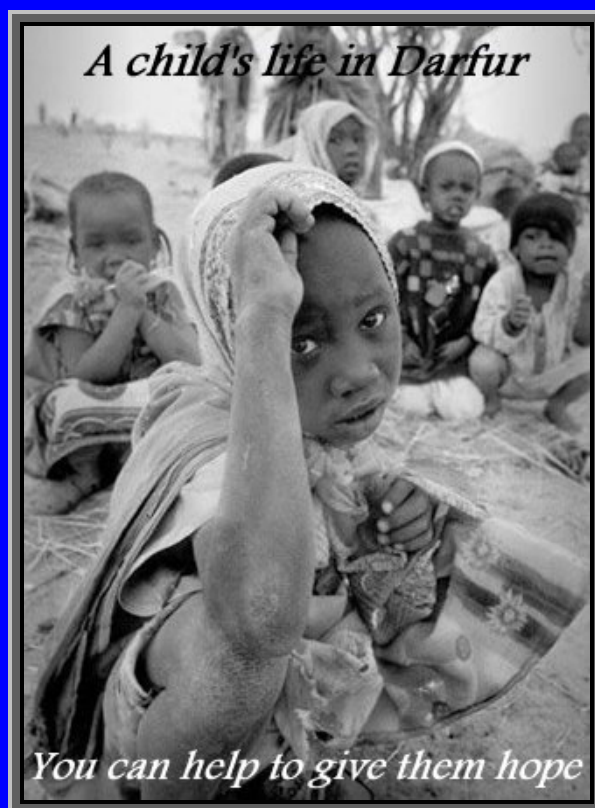
1. Information on the current needs of the children in the displaced people camps, with focus on their education needs.
2. To realize the objectives of sharing recommendations with the key stakeholders and holding consultation sessions with concerned and engaged NGOs, and within its endeavour to establish feasible links and partnerships with well established, reputable and capable organizations, the coordination committee made initial contacts with **UNICEF** and **Save the Children/Canada**. The DSF wishes to select one of these organizations as a partner in this fund raising campaign and to assist with the management of collected funds.
3. The committee is also working on establishing partnership and links with charitable organizations in Sudan. **Azza Women Association** and **Rafeeda Organization** are being considered for now.
4. To reach out to MPs and community leaders **a letter was prepared and delivered to PM. Paul Martin** a day before his departure to Sudan. This letter was e-mailed to the Forum members. Similar letters will be sent to politicians, senior government officials and the mass media.
5. The Forum **Membership** is open for anyone who believes in the Forum objectives and is willing to participate towards achieving them.

The Forum Committee earnestly pleas to everybody to be part of this noble cause.

It calls on those who find its objectives appealing to join, and on those who have already joined to be more committed and get more involved.

Remember, this is for the children of Darfur.

We thank you in advance and look forward to your support.
